**Research Students Scholarship  
for the study of Israeli society  
2020**

The Eshkol Institute supports research dealing with the Israeli society in all its aspects. The institute is offering scholarships for research students in the sum of up to 10,000 NIS per year.

Scholarship eligibility conditions

1. The scholarship supports research focusing on the study of the Israeli society.
2. Doctoral Students in stage A or B, who did not receive scholarships exceeding 125% during the current year, are eligible to apply. Before applying, please address the Faculty of Social Science accounting department to check the percentage of your scholarships.
3. Students may receive the Eshkol scholarship for a maximum of two years (consecutive or non-consecutive).
4. Scholarship recipients are expected to devote time to research and/or writing equivalent to a minimum of a part-time post.
5. At the end of the scholarship period, scholars will be asked to submit a brief summary report to the Institute. In addition, due to the Institute's commitment to making its funded research accessible to the public, scholarship recipients will submit a brief description, a paragraph or two in length, about their research and its findings, intended for public audience. The short description of the research will be posted to the institute's website.

The deadline for applications is February 20, 2020. All required documents should be sent as one PDF file via email to: [eshkol@mail.huji.ac.il](mailto:eshkol@mail.huji.ac.il)

No applications will be accepted after this date.

Each request must include the following items:

1. Application form.
2. The applicant's Curriculum Vitae
3. An application document containing the following items:

A cover letter, detailing the amount of time dedicated to doctoral studies and planned activities during the year of receiving the scholarship. In addition, the letter will explain the relevance of the research topic to the study of society in Israel, in case this is not self-evident.

- Stage A doctoral students should submit a research proposal up to three pages in length (excluding bibliography).

- Stage B doctoral students should submit an abbreviated version of their doctoral research proposal up to three pages in length (excluding bibliography). This should be an extract of the full proposal approved by the Research Students Authority

4. Recommendation letter from the dissertation supervisor.

Applicants must ensure the dissertation supervisor emails the letter of recommendation directly to [eshkol@mail.huji.ac.il](mailto:eshkol@mail.huji.ac.il) by February 20, 2020.

5. Recurring requests: Applications for the second-year should address, both in the cover letter and the reference letter, in detail the scope and pace of the candidates' progress, especially during the period of receiving the Eshkol Institute scholarship.
